



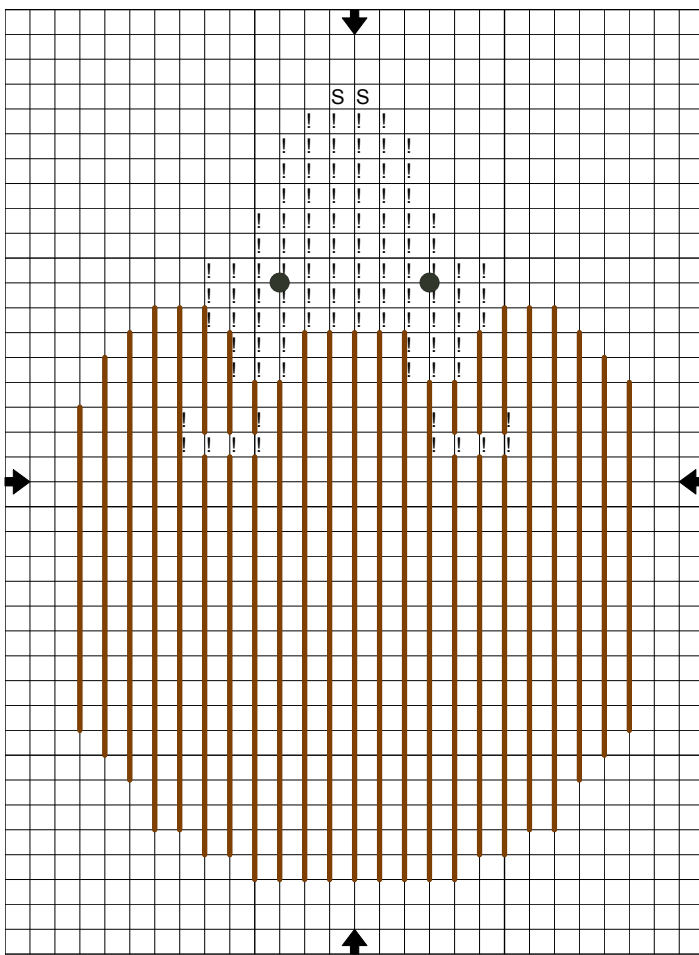

This fun and furry little fellow is a favorite with my children, though he originally started out as a pendant for me. While real hedgehogs are quite spiky, these little guys are fun to touch!

My children liked them so much that I made a set of these as mini stuffed animals for them to slip in their backpacks for long road trips. Their version is slightly simpler than the one charted here. The model for this chart is in the lower right corner of this picture, shown finished on a *Pendant Pal*.

Eyes: French Knots

Straight Stitches, 1 Strand

The fabric shown here is *Charles Craft, 14ct Willow Green* fabric. The eyes are French Knots, though *Mill Hill* beads could easily be substituted.

The silk chenille thread used for this design was obtained through www.Hand-DyedFibers.com. Check with your local needlecraft shop for availability.

The *Pendant Pal* was provided courtesy of *Tink Boord-Dill Needlework* (www.TinkBD.com). *Pendant Pals* are distributed by *Norden Crafts* and are available through your local needlecraft shop.

The children's version was finished using craft felt and was stuffed with fiber fill.

Thoughts: I found that the chenille passed through the fabric much easier if I widened the hole slightly with my needle before pulling through. Use smaller lengths to preserve the integrity of the thread. I also found it useful to use couching stitches to anchor the chenille in the middle of the hedgehog on my children's version.
